- Ends in March 2017



Satellite Clubs



- 10 Satellite Clubs running in 5 Stevenage Secondary Schools.
- Plans to run 5 new Satellite Clubs.
- Extra funding has been allocated for new clubs.



So Active



- Project is running over a 3 year period and is worth £220,504.
- Project is targeting different demographics.
- Particular focus on Bedwell Ward.
- Due to finish in June 2017.

- Child UK deliver Youth element of the project through SLA with the Council.
- Many different sports - traditional and non traditional.
- Dedicated Summer event for young people.

- HOPE Project.
- Over 60's class.
- Use the gym also learn other life skills like IT.
- Participants of HOPE project have gone on to other classes within MSC.

- Average 12 people each session.
