

Individual and Team medals for SNHAC athletes at last Cross Country League Match of the season.

Saturday 10th February saw the 5th and final league match of the Results Base Chiltern Cross Country League for 2017/18 held at Campbell Park Milton Keynes. 31 of SNHAC athletes competed in their respective age groups.

In the U11 boys matches, Abigail Manson ran another strong race finishing in 13th and placing her in 9th place for the season. In the U11 boy's race Jake Raymont, Joe Raymont, John Wiseman, Jacob Haynes, Charlie Austin, Bobby Pitman and Matthew Jones completed the same 1.5km course, finishing in 4th place of the 23 teams in both divisions.

U13 Tyler Wannerton finished 1st in Division 2 over 2.8km in 10.29 minutes with Isaac Whitten 7th and Dylan Thorman 17th giving the team a 4th place overall finish for the five matches. In the U13 Girl's 2.8km race Laura Thompson, Laura Stephens and Amy McCague all scored well and gave the team a 3rd place for the season.

Charlie Grayson was the constant in the U15 boys team and individually finished 5th over the 4.3km course with the team also in 5th place. U15 Lucy Taylor completed their 3.1km course in 12.28 minutes finishing 3rd in Division 2 with Katie Thompson in 10th and Rhea Raju 11th with the team also finishing in 3rd overall.

In the 4.3km U17/U20 Ladies race Lizzie Raymont was 13th Erin Oliver 14th Lisa Barber was 18th and Bethany Dean in 20th - 2nd and 3rd U20s. The combined team finishing 5th. Lisa collecting an individual Silver medal for her efforts in the U20 women's event.

In the U17 Men's race Sam Wiggins collected bronze medal for his efforts over 5.6km, with Charlie Major finishing in 8th and the team were 4th.

In the senior Women's 5.6km race Chris Feely continued her good form collecting a 2nd place trophy in her age group with another strong run.

The senior/veteran men's race saw U20 Harry Major the first home over the 8.4km course, putting the U20 Junior men's into 2nd place in the team event, followed by Vets Stephen Mayfield, Tony Carolan Trevor Mason Steve Feely and Joe Rayapan finishing the final race of the season.
